This more affordable, high quality product is said to cost customers between 58 and 75 percent less than the current life-critical medications currently available at other retailers – marking a major step forward in managing the financial burden so many diabetics and their families face.

Does ReliOn™ NovoLog® require a prescription?

Yes, ReliOn™ NovoLog® does require a prescription.

When will ReliOn™ NovoLog® be available?

Walmart's ReliOn™ NovoLog® vials and FlexPens are available now at Walmart and select Sam's Club locations across the United States.

Will ReliOn™ NovoLog® be covered by my insurance?

At this time, it is unclear which insurances will cover ReliOn™ NovoLog®. We will continue to update this FAQ page once more information becomes available.

If not covered by insurance, how much will ReliOn™ NovoLog® cost?

If you do not have insurance or if your insurance does not cover this insulin, the cost will be \$72.88 for a 10mL vial and \$85.88 for a pack of 5 pens (3mL each). It is expected that customers will save between 58 and 75 percent off cash price of other brand insulin products.

Are other ReliOn™ insulins available?

While Walmart does offer other ReliOn™ insulin products, these are inferior to ReliOn™ NovoLog®.
